

Scrum allows companies to launch better products onto the market within shorter periods of time. Particularly complex IT projects and product developments require professional management with a clear focus on the customer benefit and on creating value. In order for this to work successfully, development teams are provided with a designated scrum master, who helps them to improve how they collaborate not only with each other, but also with the company in general.

This three-day, practice-based company training teaches participants the techniques that will help scrum masters to successfully launch scrum in a team, to support the product owner in his or her day-to-day activities and improve self-organization within the development team.
