

Scrum, probably the most well-known process model for agile project management, allows companies to launch better products onto the market within shorter periods of time. For this reason, the agile method has established itself as an alternative approach in recent years. Particularly complex IT projects and product developments require professional management with a clear focus on the customer benefit and on creating value. The combination of short work cycles, frequent feedback and working in self-organized teams provides.

This two-day company training provides an ideal introduction to agile project management using scrum. It teaches participants the basics of scrum and presents other agile methods and techniques that will help them to work successfully in an agile team. Participants will receive an overview of the idea behind the method and its benefits, will learn about the entire scrum process with all of its planning and management mechanisms, and will become familiar with working in sprints.
